

- 1 The Heart of Illinois United Way partners with 46 health and human care agencies funding 83 programs through a multi-year grant process.
- 2 The Heart of Illinois United Way is the largest non-governmental funder of local health and human care programs.
- 3 Contributions stay in central Illinois supporting Peoria, Tazewell, Woodford, Stark, Marshall and Putnam counties.
- 4 89 cents of every dollar raised by the Heart of Illinois United Way directly supports critical health and human care programs in central Illinois.
- 5 Heart of Illinois United Way funding is a reliable and steady source of income for our partner agencies.
- 6 The Heart of Illinois United Way operates in one of the smallest metropolitan populations in the nation to raise more than \$10 million annually. In 2016, the annual campaign raised \$11,042,893.
