

How to Use the Day of Caring Food Drive 'Can Dollar'

A *Can Dollar* is something that an employee can purchase instead of going to the grocery store and buying food to donate.

If an employee wants to participate in your Day of Caring Food Drive, but they have forgotten to purchase items or have not had the time, let them buy a *Can Dollar*!

As your food drive chair, here's what you'll do - collect \$1 per *Can Dollar* and then at the end of your drive, use the collected money to purchase additional food or personal hygiene items. For example, three *Can Dollars* would be the equivalent to bringing in three cans of food.

There are four 'dollars' per sheet. Simply copy and cut out them out and give to the employees for them to put up in their office or in a designated area to show that they have participated in your Day of Caring Food Drive.
