School readiness is more than knowing letters, numbers, and identifying colors and shapes. Children who are ready for school have good social, self-help, and physical skills and are developing a love of learning.

School Registration Information

All parents/legal guardians of children who will be five years of age on or before September 1, are encouraged to register their children for kindergarten. Early registration begins as early as March 1 for some schools.

Check with your local school district for your kindergarten registration information.

In most cases, the parent/legal guardian will need to bring the following for kindergarten registration:

- Child's official birth certificate (with raised seal)
- Child's social security number
- Proof of residency (required for all registrants) - copy of signed mortgage, contract to build or lease agreement showing the owner/resident's name and address or two of the following items:
 - Utility bills with your name and address
 - Valid driver's license
 - Voter registration card
 - State medical card
- Notarized affidavit of residency from the parent or person with whom the child is residing, affirming that the child eats and sleeps at the residence



Time to Visit the Doctor and the Dentist

All entering kindergarten students must provide documentation of a current physical examination and immunizations prior to starting school and, proof of a dental exam.

It is recommended that you make your child's appointments for a **kindergarten physical and dental exam by April or even earlier.**

Students who do not have physical and dental exams by the first day of school may not be allowed to attend school.

Below are the minimum requirements for school entry. Your local Dept. of Public Health and/or your doctor may recommend additional exams or immunizations.

If your child is entering preschool . . .

- Physical Exam
- 4 DTaP Shots (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis)
- 3 Polio Shots
- 1 HIB Shot (Meningitis) (1 or more doses)
- 1 MMR Shot (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- 3 Hepatitis-B Shots
- 1 Varicella Shot (Chicken Pox) or proof of disease
- TB Screening
- Lead Screening
- Blood Test

If your child is entering kindergarten . . .

- Physical Exam
- Eye Exam
- Dental Exam
- DTaP Booster
- Polio Booster
- MMR Shot
- 1 Varicella Shot (Chicken Pox) or proof of disease
- Lead Screening
- Blood Test

School Readiness Checklist

Use these checklists to prepare your child for school. These goals can be accomplished through everyday routines or enjoyable activities. If you're behind in some areas, don't worry, because children grow and develop at different rates.

For Good Health and Physical Well-Being, My Child:

- Eats a balanced diet that is low in sugar and saturated fats
- Gets plenty of rest including eight hours of sleep at night
- Receives regular medical and dental care
- Has had all the necessary immunizations
- Runs, jumps and plays outdoors for exercise
- Works puzzles, draws, colors and more



For Social and Emotional Preparation, My Child:

- Is learning to explore and try new things
- Is learning to work alone
- Is curious and motivated to learn
- Is learning to use self-control
- Is learning to use words to express emotions
- Has opportunities to be with other children
- Is learning to cooperate with others
- Is learning to finish tasks
- Can follow simple instructions
- Helps with family chores

For Language and General Knowledge, My Child:

- Has many opportunities to talk and listen
- Watches television monitored by an adult
- Is learning to write his/her name and address
- Is learning to identify shapes and colors
- Is encouraged to dance, run, jump and play
- Has opportunities to see and hear new things
- Is read to every day
- Is encouraged to ask questions
- Is learning to count
- Has opportunities to be creative
- Has opportunities to taste new foods
- Has opportunities to listen and make music
