- The Heart of Illinois United Way partners with 47 agencies to address education, financial stabiltiy and health needs in central Illinois.
- Through a multi-year grant process, 89 programs and initiatives will receive funding in 2018-2019 as the first year of a new funding cycle.
- The Heart of Illinois United Way is the largest non-governmental funder of local health and human care programs.
- Contributions stay in central Illinois supporting Peoria, Tazewell, Woodford, Stark, Marshall and Putnam counties.
- 5 89 cents of every dollar raised by the Heart of Illinois United Way directly supports critical health and human care programs in central Illinois.
- 6 Heart of Illinois United Way funding is a reliable and steady source of income for our partner agencies.
- The Heart of Illinois United Way operates in one of the smallest metropolitan populations in the nation to raise more than \$10 million annually. In 2017, the annual campaign raised \$11,08,500.

Each year, locally funded United Way programs positively impact 100,000 people throughout central Illinois.
